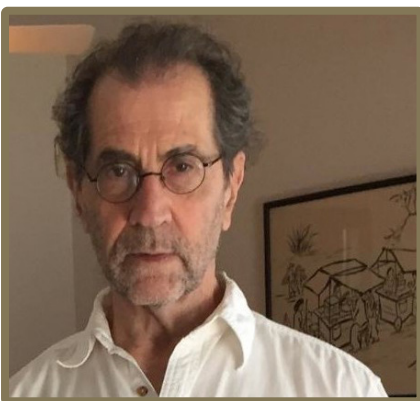

**Carl L. Bankston III** is professor of sociology at Tulane University. His most recent books include *American Ideas of Equality: A Social History, 1750-2020* (Cambria, 2021), *The Rise of the New Second Generation* (with Min Zhou; Polity, 2016); and *Immigrant Networks and Social Capital* (Polity, 2014). His research interests include international migration, sociology of education, stratification, historical sociology, and sociology of religion. Social capital theory has consistently been a dominant theoretical framework across all of these areas.
